A problem in the adult public use microdata file (PUMF) for the 2001 Aboriginal Peoples Survey has been discovered, affecting the variables I09ACAMP ("During the year ending December 31st, 2000, did you or other members of your household use the following items for harvesting country food, gathering firewood or for unpaid household work? Camping tent?") and I09BCAMP ("Is the camping tent owned by you or a member of your household?").

There is a problem with SPSS being able to distinguish the different values of these variables. Therefore, it is recommended that SPSS users refrain from using the variables I09ACAMP and I09BCAMP until a new version of the product is issued in the near future.

Users should also be aware of a textual error in Appendix B (Data Dictionary) of the English user guide for the variable I02L30_P. The variable description should read:

"During the year ending December 31st, 2000, did.....have a paid part-time job (less than 30 hours a week), not including self-employment?"
