CANADIAN TRAVEL SURVEY
Micro File Documentation

The micro file of the Canadian Travel Survey (CTS) contains information on the travel habits of Canadians for one quarter of the year.

Included in this documentation package along with this overview are the dataset record layouts, the coefficients of variation, and the survey questionnaire.

CTS DATASETS

The micro file contains 4 datasets, each one to be used to produce specific types of travel statistics. Following are the names and main uses of each dataset.

1. Person dataset

- used for statistics related to travellers
- Name - SPEC.CTSyymm.MICRO.PERSON
yy=year, mm=month of survey

2. Person-trip/Trip dataset

- used for trip-related statistics
- Name - SPEC.CTSyymm.MICRO.PTRIP

3. Person-night dataset

- used for statistics related to nights spent away from home.
- Name - SPEC.CTSyymm.MICRO.PNIGHT

~~4. Reallocated Expenditures dataset~~

- ~~- used for expenditure statistics by type and location where money was spent.~~
- ~~Name - SPEC.CTSyymm.MICRO.REALEXP~~

RECORD LAYOUT

Most of the variables on each of the 4 datasets are common, therefore the accompanying record layout contains both a section on these common variables, plus sections for additional variables in each specific dataset. These are the differences between the 4 datasets:

1. Person dataset (traveller statistics)

- one record per survey respondent
- each record contains
 - traveller/non-traveller demographics
 - information on all trips taken in the quarter
- field 15, person weight
 - this weighting factor is used to produce estimates of traveller statistics.
 - the position and field size of the person weight are: (28-36) and 9, (9(5)V9(4)).

2. Person-trip/Trip dataset

- one record per unique trip taken
 - if identical trips were taken during the quarter then this was built into the weighting factors.
- field 15, person-trip weight
 - this weighting factor is used to produce travel volume estimates in person-trips.
 - DO NOT use this weight for expenditure estimates
 - the position and field size of the person-trip weight are: (28-37) and 10, (9(6)V9(4)).
- field 16, trip weight
 - this weighting factor is used to produce trip characteristics, including reported expenditures estimates.
 - the position and field size of the trip weight are: (38-47) and 10, (9(6)V9(4)).
- NOTE. This dataset can also be used to produce person-night statistics. Multiply the person-trip weight (field 15) by the "nights spent" fields (#45, 46, and 47).

3. Person-night dataset

- one record per overnight trip
- identical variables to the person-trip/trip dataset, except for field 15
- field 15, person-night weight
 - use this weight to produce estimates of person-nights spent away from home.
 - see NOTE under "Person-trip/Trip dataset" above.
 - the position and field size of the person-night weight are: (28-38) and 11, (9(7)V9(4)).

~~4. Reallocated Expenditures dataset~~

- ~~- one record per trip where household members had expenditures.~~
- ~~- to create this dataset, reported expenditures (those obtained on the questionnaire) were reallocated in two ways (see page 4 for details).~~
 - ~~- to location where the money was spent (16 codes)~~
 - ~~- to type of expenditures (8 types)~~

~~Thus there are 128 (8 * 16) expenditure variables added to this dataset.~~
- field 16, trip weight
 - use this weight to produce expenditure statistics.
 - the position and field size of the trip weight are: (38-47) and 10, (9(6)V9(4))

COEFFICIENTS OF VARIATION

Every statistic produced from a sample survey is subject to sampling variability. If the survey had been conducted twice at the same point in time with two different samples, statistics produced from the two sources would be expected to differ slightly. This is sampling variability.

In principal, statistics based on fewer records have higher sampling variabilities and smaller estimates typically have higher sampling variabilities.

The tables of coefficients of variation (CV's) provide measures of data reliability (sampling variability) for household trip, person-trip, person-night and person data for statistics at the Canada level and provincial level. If the CV (column entry under type of data) of a statistic produced from the micro file is less than 16.5, then use the statistic without qualification. If the CV is between 16.5 and 25.0, then use the estimate with caution. Although these CV's likely lead to conservative use of the data, we recommend that estimates with a CV over 25.0 not be used.

In order to use these tables follow these steps:

1. Choose the table for the geographic area corresponding to your statistic.
2. Find the row in the estimate column nearest the size of your statistic in thousands.
3. Read the CV in the column corresponding to the type of statistic you have (person-trip, etc).

QUESTIONNAIRE

Included is a copy of the questionnaire used to collect CTS data for this quarter. Socio-demographic data is collected by the Labour Force Survey and selected variables are combined with CTS data to produce the micro file.

ENQUÊTE SUR LES VOYAGES DES CANADIENS

Microfichier et documents

Le microfichier de l'enquête sur les voyages des Canadiens (EVC) renferme de l'information sur les habitudes de voyage des Canadiens pour un trimestre de l'année.

Outre le présent aperçu, l'ensemble documentaire réuni sur l'enquête susmentionnée comprend les clichés d'enregistrement propres aux ensembles de données, les coefficients de variation et le questionnaire d'enquête.

ENSEMBLE DE DONNÉES DE L'EVC

Le microfichier se compose de quatre (4) ensembles de données, chacun servant à la production de différentes statistiques sur les voyages. Sont présentées ci-après la désignation et la principale utilité de chacun des quatre ensembles.

1. Ensemble de données sur les personnes

- utilisé pour les statistiques liées aux voyageurs
- Désignation - ECTD.STATCAN.CTSyymm.MICRO.PERSON
yy=année, mmm=mois de l'enquête

2. Ensemble de données sur les voyages-personnes

- utilisé pour les statistiques liées aux voyages
- Désignation - ECTD.STATCAN.CTSyymm.MICRO.PTRIP

3. Ensemble de données sur les nuitées-personnes

- utilisé pour les statistiques liées au nombre de nuits passées à l'extérieur
- Désignation - ECTD.STATCAN.CTSyymm.MICRO.PNIGHT

4. Ensemble de données sur les dépenses réaffectées

- ~~- utilisé pour les statistiques liées aux dépenses, selon le genre de dépenses et l'endroit bénéficiaire~~
- ~~- Désignation - ECTD.STATCAN.CTSyymm.MICRO.REALEXP~~

CLICHE D'ENREGISTREMENT

La plupart des variables propres à chacun des quatre ensembles de données étant des variables communes, le cliché d'enregistrement de chaque ensemble comporte une section réservée à ces variables plus d'autres sections consacrées aux variables additionnelles. Voici les différences marquant les quatre ensembles.

1. Ensemble de données sur les personnes (statistiques sur les voyageurs)

- un enregistrement par répondant à l'enquête
- chaque enregistrement comprend:
 - les caractéristiques démographiques du répondant (voyageur ou non voyageur)
 - de l'information sur tous les voyages effectués durant le trimestre étudié
- zone 15, coefficient "personnes"
 - ce coefficient de pondération sert à estimer les statistiques sur les voyageurs
 - la position et la longueur de la zone du coefficient "personnes" sont: (28-36) et 9, (9(5)V9(4)).

2. Ensemble de données sur les voyages-personnes

- un enregistrement par voyage
 - sont pris en compte dans les coefficients de pondération les voyages identiques effectués au cours du trimestre
- zone 15, coefficient "voyages-personnes"
 - ce coefficient de pondération sert à estimer les voyages, selon le rapport voyages-personnes
 - NE PAS utiliser ce coefficient pour les estimations des dépenses
 - la position et la longueur de la zone du coefficient "voyages-personnes" sont: (28-37) et 10, (9(6)V9(4)).
- zone 16, coefficient "voyages"
 - ce coefficient de pondération sert à établir les caractéristiques des voyages ainsi que les estimations des dépenses déclarées
 - la position et la longueur de la zone du coefficient "voyages" sont: (38-47) et 10, (9(6)V9(4)).

NOTA. Cet ensemble de données peut aussi servir à produire des statistiques sur les nuitées-personnes. Il s'agit de multiplier le coefficient "nuitées-personnes" (zone 15) par le nombre de nuitées (zones 45, 46 et 47).

3. Ensemble de données sur les nuitées-personnes,

- un enregistrement par voyage d'une nuitée ou plus
- les variables de cet ensemble sont identiques à celles de l'ensemble sur les voyages-personnes et sur les voyages, sauf dans le cas de la zone 15
- zone 15, coefficient "nuitées-personnes"
 - ce coefficient de pondération sert à estimer le nombre de nuitées-personnes par voyage
 - voir la NOTA de l'ensemble sur les voyages-personnes (ci-haut)
 - la position et la longueur de la zone du coefficient "nuitées-personnes" sont (28-38) et 11, (9(7)V9(4)).

4. Ensemble de données sur les dépenses réaffectées

- un enregistrement par voyage dans les cas où les membres du ménage ont effectué des dépenses

- pour créer le présent ensemble de données, les dépenses déclarées (dans le questionnaire) ont été réaffectées selon deux formules (pour plus de détails, se reporter à la page 9):
- l'endroit où les dépenses ont été faites (16 codes)
 - le genre de dépenses (8 genres)
- Ainsi, 128 (8 * 16) variables de dépenses ont été ajoutées au présent ensemble.
- zone 16, coefficient "voyages"
- ce coefficient de pondération sert à produire des statistiques sur les dépenses
 - la position et la longueur de la zone du coefficient "voyage" sont: (38-47) et 10, (9(6)V9(4)).

COEFFICIENTS DE VARIATION

Toutes les statistiques produites à partir d'une enquête-échantillon sont nécessairement touchées par la variabilité d'échantillonnage. Par exemple, des statistiques qui seraient tirées de deux enquêtes parfaitement identiques réalisées au même moment auprès de deux échantillons distincts présenteraient vraisemblablement de légères différences. C'est ce que l'on appelle la variabilité d'échantillonnage.

En principe, les statistiques fondées sur un plus petit nombre d'enregistrements présentent des variabilités d'échantillonnage plus grandes, et les estimations plus petites d'accompagnent aussi généralement de variabilités d'échantillonnage plus grandes.

Les tableaux des coefficients de variation (CV) fournissent des mesures de la fiabilité des données (variabilité d'échantillonnage) sur les voyages-ménages, les voyages-personnes, les nuitées-personnes et les personnes, à l'échelle nationale et à l'échelle provinciale. Si le CV (figurant dans la colonne intitulée "genre de données") de statistiques tirées du microfichier est inférieur à 16.5, on peut alors utiliser lesdites statistiques sans réserve. S'il se situe par contre entre 16.5 et 25.0, il faut alors les utiliser avec prudence. Bien que les CV du présent microfichier conduisent sans doute à une utilisation conservatrice des données, nous recommandons de ne pas utiliser les estimations dont le CV est supérieur à 25.0.

Voici comment utiliser les tableaux.

1. Sélectionnez le tableau de la région géographique qui correspond aux statistiques qui vous intéressent.
2. Dans la colonne des estimations, trouvez la rangée dont les chiffres se rapprochent le plus de la valeur de vos statistiques, en milliers.
3. Relevez le CV qui est indiqué dans la colonne correspondant au genre de statistiques qui vous intéressent (voyages-personnes, etc.).

QUESTIONNAIRE

Un exemplaire du questionnaire utilisé pour recueillir les données de l'EVC pour le trimestre à l'étude est annexé au présent document. Les données socio-démographiques sont recueillies au moyen de l'enquête sur la population active, et certaines variables sont ensuite combinées avec les données de l'EVC en vue de produire un microfichier de données.
