## **FOOTNOTES FOR STATISTICAL TABLES 1993-94**

- (a) Unless otherwise noted, all fees and costs are for two semesters (eight months) or 30 credits (in Quebec).
- (b) Additional fees are charged for specific courses or for co-op students on work terms for which credit hours are granted.
- (c) For 30 credits.
- (d) Students may pay between \$5 and \$150 per course for materials.
- (e) Estimated figure.
- (f) Data have been adjusted to reflect 30 credits at \$68/credit in 1993-94 and \$73.25/credit in 1994-95, with the exceptions of law, medicine and dentistry which have set fees based on an 8 month academic year.
- (g) Pre-Agriculture/Pre-Architecture/Pre-Dentistry/Pre-Engineering/Pre-Law/Pre-Medicine.
- (h) Tuition fees reported were based on 36 credit units. The data have been adjusted to reflect 30 credit units.
- (i) Courses offered at École des Hautes Études Commerciales.
- (j) Tuition fees reported were based on 12 months. The data have been adjusted to reflect 2 semesters (8 months).
- (k) Dentistry students pay a dental kit fee ranging from \$5,804 for first year students to \$1,011 for fourth year students.
- (I) Includes equipment fee of \$50.
- (m) Courses offered at École Polytechnique.
- (n) Engineering students pay a \$100 equipment fund fee.
- (o) Surcharge of \$380 on private music study courses.
- (p) Tuition fees for the veterinary medicine program (DMV) were \$29,582 in 1993-94 and \$31,000 in 1994-95.
- (q) For the first year, then a lesser fee is charged for each subsequent year of the program.
- (r) Data have been adjusted to reflect 30 credits at \$170/credit in 1993-94 and \$183/credit in 1994-95, with the exceptions of law, medicine and dentistry which have set fees based on an 8 month academic year.
- (s) Tuition fees for the Executive MBA program are between \$5,400 and \$11,100 per academic year.
- (t) Tuition fees reported were based on 24 months. The data have been adjusted to reflect 2 semesters (8 months).
- (u) Included in student association fees.
- (v) A special fee is charged to foreign students.

- (w) Athletic and health service fees are included in tuition fees, except at École des Hautes Études Commerciales and École Polytechnique where athletic and health services fees ranged from \$75 to \$150 in 1994-95. These affiliates also have other fees including fees that apply only to foreign students.
- (x) Accommodation costs are for university-operated residences and housing. Not included are: accommodations in off-campus private quarters; transportation; and personal expenditures for books, clothing, entertainment, etc.
- (y) Tuition fees reported were based on 12 months. The data have not been adjusted to reflect 2 semesters (8 months) because of the different nature of graduate studies which also includes a research component which is not course related.
- (z) Graduate students are charged an annual registration fee for each term registered in addition to this one time program fee. Tuition for PHD students is \$4575 for the 1993-94 academic year.
- (aa) Differential fee for foreign students effective for 1993-94. Programs allow for a 36 credit maximum.
- (ab) Queen's University offers a degree program in Nursing and Rehabilitation Therapy. Tuition fees for the Nursing program are \$2026 for Canadian students and \$11891 for foreign students for the 1993-94 academic year. Tuition fees for the Rehabilitation Therapy program are \$2026 for Canadian students and \$7294 for foreign students for the 1993-94 academic year.
- (ac) Until January 15, 1994, the University of Winnipeg has a rebate program to eliminate the differential between fees charged to Canadian students and foreign students to counter the 75% surcharge on the tuition of international students instituted by the Province of Manitoba.
- (ad) For the 1993-94 academic year, Brandon University will rebate the 75% surcharge on the tuition of international students instituted by the Province of Manitoba.
- (ae) Increases in foreign student tuition fees for the 1993-94 academic year are due to a 75% surcharge instituted by the Province of Manitoba.
- (af) Tuition fees reported were based on 12 months. The data have not been adjusted to reflect 2 semesters (8 months) because of the different nature of graduate studies which also includes a research component which is not course related.
- (ag) Tuition fees for the MBA program are between \$4200 and \$9390 per academic year.
- (ah) In addition to this one time program fee, graduate students are charged an annual registration fee for each term registered.
- (ai) Tuition fees for the Doctor of Veterinary Medicine programs are \$2832 for Canadian students and \$29582 for foreign students for the 1993-94 academic year.
- (aj) Tuition fees for the MBA program are \$2032 for Canadian students and \$9344 for foreign students per an 8-month academic year (1993-94).
- (ak) Data was reported per half course (Master of Education program). Data have been adjusted to reflect one academic year (10 half course).
- (al) Returning Canadian students pay \$250 and returning out-of-country students pay \$3395. The graduate program consist of a small number of students also engaged in assisting the teaching staff.
