Subject: Typographical modifications in the descriptions for Work Stress (WST) Derived Variables and change in Derived Variable code for WSTDJST.			
Product(s) affected: Master and share files (released September 18 th 2013) and public use microdata file (released April 3 rd 2014)			
Year(s) affected: 2012			
<p>Description of the problem(s): After the release of the data file in September 2013, the following typographical revisions were made to some Derived Variable descriptions.</p> <p>Most changes only affect the variable descriptions and therefore the data are not impacted. However, the derived variable WSTDJST had an error in the specifications which also resulted in the variable being calculated incorrectly. Data users who are working with the WSTDJST variable are instructed to use the code provided in this Errata to correct the variable.</p>

It is based on questions about whether the respondent was required to keep learning new things, whether his/her job required a high level of skill and whether the job required that the respondent do things over and over (monotony).</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Higher scores indicate that lower skills are required for the job. 2. According to the original instrument, higher scores indicate greater work stress. 3. Scores were inversed in the temporary reformat for question WST_Q404.” 	Derived Variable document

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WSTDAUT	E, F	<p>Revised description - Description should be changed to:</p> <p>“This variable indicates whether the respondent’s main job in the past 12 months allows them freedom in how to do their job and if they have a lot of say in what happens with regard to their job.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Higher scores indicate lower decision authority. 2. Higher scores indicate greater work stress.” 	Derived Variable document
WSTDPSY	E, F	<p>Revised description - Description should be changed to:</p> <p>“This variable indicates the respondent’s psychological demands in their main job in the past 12 months. It is based on questions about whether the respondent is free from conflicting demands and if their main job in the past 12 months is very hectic.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Higher scores indicate greater psychological demands. 2. Higher scores indicate greater work stress. 3. Scores were inverted in the temporary reformat for question WST_Q405.” 	Derived Variable document
WSTDJIN	E, F	<p>Revised description - Description should be changed to:</p> <p>“This variable indicates how the respondent feels about their level of job security in their main job.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Higher scores indicate greater job insecurity. 2. Higher scores indicate greater work stress.” 	Derived Variable document
WSTDPHY	E, F	<p>Revised description - Description should be changed to:</p> <p>“This variable indicates whether the main job in the past 12 months requires a lot of physical effort.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Higher scores indicate greater physical demands at work. 2. Higher scores indicate greater work stress.” 	Derived Variable document

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WSTDSOC	E, F	<p>Revised description - Description should be changed to:</p> <p>“This variable indicates the social support available to the respondent at his/her main job in the past 12 months. It is based on questions about whether or not the supervisor and the people the respondent worked with were helpful in getting the job done, and whether the respondent was exposed to hostility or conflict from the people they worked with.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Higher scores indicate lower social support at work. 2. Higher scores indicate greater work stress. 3. Scores were inversed in the temporary reformat for question WST_Q410.” 	Derived Variable document
WSTDJST	E, F	<p>Revised description - Description should be changed to:</p> <p>“This variable indicates whether the respondent experienced job strain at their main work in the past 12 months. Job strain is measured as a ratio of psychological demands to decision latitude which includes skill discretion (skill attitudes) and decision authority.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Higher scores indicate greater job strain. 2. Higher scores indicate greater work stress. 3. Scores are inversed here for questions WST_Q401, WST_Q402, WST_Q403, WST_Q409 (decision latitude questions) for use in the denominator. Since WST_Q404 had been inversed for the calculation of WSTDSKI, it is inversed again before calculating WSTDJST. 4. At the beginning of this section, scores were inversed in the temporary reformat for question WST_Q405. The inversed WST_Q405 is used here (as in WTSDPSY).” <p>New note for the specifications of the DV (see step 3 on next page): “All items have +1 added to them so that the denominator will not be 0 under any combination of answers.”</p>	Derived Variable document

Description of the problem(s): After the release of the Public Use Microdata file (PUMF) in April 2014, the following minor typographical errors in the CCHS – Mental Health master, share and PUMF data dictionary, labels and format files were detected. Revised versions of the labels and formats have been created for all three file types. In addition, the data dictionary has been re-created for the PUMF. Note: All of the errors concern the metadata. No errors have been found in the data. The following corrections have been made.
