\* SAS ® and SPSS ® label files are an electronic version of the variable name and the concept field from the data dictionary. The concept field in some variables has been shortened for use as a SAS or SPSS variable label.

The ASCII files contain decimal points coded in the data. The decimal symbol on your system MUST be the dot (variables with decimals would otherwise be converted to missing). Follow the appropriate steps for your Operating System to do so. An example is as follows:
