---

### **Beyond 20/20 files: There are six different extracts.**

- 1) PERSON file: The extract is called PERS.IVX.
- 2) PERSON-TRIP file: The extract is called PTRI.IVX
- 3) VISIT files: There are four VISIT files.
  - The extract representing the VISIT file at the province level is called VIPR.IVX.
  - The extract representing the VISIT file at the Census Metropolitan Area level is called VCMA.IVX.
  - The extract representing the VISIT file at the Census Division level is called VICD.IVX.
  - The extract representing the VISIT file at the tourism region level is called VITR.IVX.

### **Microdata files: There are seven different datasets.**

Since there are 12 files representing each month for each dataset, all the files are identified as such. For example, the January PERSON file would be called PERS9701.DAT, the February file is called PERS9702.DAT, etc.

- 1) PERSON file: The microdata files are all called PERS97\_\_.DAT.
  - 2) TRIP file: The microdata files are all called TRIP97\_\_.DAT.
  - 3) PERSON-TRIP file: The microdata files are all called PTRI97\_\_.DAT.
  - 4) VISIT files: There are four different VISIT files for each month.  
The microdata files representing the VISIT file at the
    - province level are all called PROV97\_\_.DAT.
    - Census Metropolitan Area level are all called CMA97\_\_.DAT.
    - Census Division level are all called CDIV97\_\_.DAT.
    - Tourism region level are all called TREG97\_\_.DAT.

---

**\_HHTRWT**

**Long variable name:** Household-trip weight

**Description:**

Household-trip weight. The household-trip weight can be associated with the trip characteristics as well as the expenditures information. It *cannot* be associated with socio-demographic characteristics of the respondents. The household-trip weight is to be used to measure the number of household-trips taken and reported expenditures.

*Note: This variable is included on the Beyond 20/20 PERSON-TRIP file. This field is always set at 0 for child records.*

**\_PERSWT**

**Long variable name:** Person weight

**Description:**

Person weight. It can be associated with all the socio-demographic variables describing the respondent. Used with the person records, the user can get a socio-demographic profile of travellers and non-travellers or calculate travel incidences. The person weight *cannot* be used to measure the volume of person-trips.

*Note: This variable is included on the Beyond 20/20 PERSON file.*

**\_PTRIPWT**

**Long variable name:** Person-trip weight

**Description:**

Person-trip weight. This weight can only be associated with those people who have taken a trip, that is the travellers. It can be associated with the socio-demographic characteristics of the travellers as well as the trip characteristics such as origin, destination or purpose. It *cannot* be associated with expenditures of trips.

*Note: This variable is included on the Beyond 20/20 PERSON-TRIP file.*

**\_PVISWT**

**Long variable name:** Person-visit weight

**Description:**

Person-visit weight. This weight is to be used when compiling person-visit information from the visit files. It is used to measure the number of person-visits. It can be associated with all the socio-demographic and visit variables.

*Note: This variable is included on the Beyond 20/20 VISIT files.*

**\_REXPWT**

**Long variable name:** Reallocated expenditures weight

**Description:**

Reallocated expenditures weight. This weight should be used to compile reallocated expenditures information using the visit file. It can be associated only with reallocated expenditures related variables.

*Note: This variable is included on the Beyond 20/20 VISIT files. This field is always set at 0 for child records.*

**Long variable name:** Visiting friends or relatives

**Description:**

Specifies if the traveller visited friends or relatives while on the trip.

### ACTIV4

**Long variable name:** Attended a festival, fair or exhibition

**Description:**

Specifies if the traveller attended a festival, a fair or an exhibition while on the trip. This includes any of the thousands of planned fairs and festivals which occur at a specific time each year. Examples are: St. John's Regatta (Newfoundland), Lobster Carnival and livestock exhibitions, Summerside (Prince-Edward Island), Shediac Lobster Festival (New Brunswick), Glengarry Highland Games, Maxville (Ontario), Shrimp Festival, Matane (Quebec), Winnipeg folk Festival (Manitoba), Comox Valley Renaissance Fair, Courtenay (British Columbia), Festival of Arts, Banff (Alberta), Saskatchewan Hand Craft Festival, Saskatoon (Saskatchewan), etc.

Specifies if the traveller visited a zoo or a natural exhibit while on the trip. Natural exhibit means living things are not in their natural habitat but are placed together to form a display or presentation. Sometimes natural exhibits, such as the Biodome in Montreal or Muttart's conservatory in Edmonton, are set up to demonstrate various living plants and animals in different climates. Some examples involving animals are park safaris, aquariums and insectariums. Some examples involving plants are botanical gardens and various gardens and greenhouses set up as showpieces.

**Long variable name:** Nights camping

**Description:**

While on the trip, number of nights spent in a camping or trailer park, that is an establishment which provides sites for tents, trailers, recreational vehicles (RVs) and/or campers. It is owned either privately or by the government.

**CAROPS**

**Long variable name:** Reported expenditures private or rented vehicle operation

**Description:**

While on the trip, amount of money spent on the operation of a private or rented vehicle namely for gasoline, repairs and parking costs. The amount reported includes all taxes and tips.

*Note: This variable is included on the Beyond 20/20 PERSON-TRIP file and on the TRIP and PERSON-TRIP microdata files. On the Beyond 20/20 file, this field is always set at 0 for child records and on the microdata files, it is always blank for child records.*

**CARRIER**

**Long variable name:** Canadian air carrier

**Description:**

In cases where air was used as the main mode of transport to reach the destination, this specifies if the respondent used a Canadian air carrier. If a Canadian air carrier was used only part of the way, and a carrier of another national origin was used for another part, respondents answer according to the carrier which reached the farthest distance.

## CLOTHES

**Long variable name:** Reported expenditures clothing

**Description:**

While on the trip, amount of money spent on any clothing purchases whether they were gifts or for personal use. The amount reported includes all taxes and tips.

*Note: This variable is included on the Beyond 20/20 PERSON-TRIP file and on the TRIP and PERSON-TRIP microdata files. On the Beyond 20/20 file, this field is always set at 0 for child records and on the microdata files, it is always blank for child records.*

**Long variable name:** Number of CMA records

**Description:**

Number of Census Metropolitan Area visit records attached to this trip.

**Long variable name:** Attended a convention

**Description:**

In cases where the respondent went on a business trip, specifies if this traveller attended a business convention, that is an assembly or gathering, often periodic, for a common purpose by members or delegates of a professional or other business-related group.

## DECD

**Long variable name:** CD of destination

**Description:**

Census Division of destination. Census Divisions are areas established by provincial laws which are intermediate geographic areas between the municipality (Census Subdivision) and the province level. Census Divisions represent counties, regional districts, regional municipalities and other types of provincially legislated areas. It corresponds to the place reported by the respondent as the destination of the trip. If the respondent visited more than one place during a trip, the destination is the place furthest from their home. On the Beyond 20/20 files, the first two digits represent the province code and the last two digits correspond to the Census Division code. On the microdata files, one has to combine the DEPROV and DECD variables to get the four digit code.
