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Survey of Labour and Income Dynamics (SLIE):
Preliminary, Labour and Income Interview Questionnaire for
Reference Year 2007

Executive summary

The Survey of Labour and Income Dynamics (SLID) is a national household survey which collects information related to the standard of living of individuals and their families. By interviewing the same people over a period of six years, we are able to monitor these changes and their causes.

A preliminary interview of background information is collected for all respondents aged 16 and over, who enter the SLID sample. Preliminary interviews are conducted for new household members during their first labour and income interview after they join the household. A labour and income interview is collected each year for all respondents 16 years of age and over.

The purpose of this document is to present the questions, possible responses and question flows for the 2008 preliminary, labour and income questionnaire (for the 2007 reference year).

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1 Introduction

Every January, the *Survey of Labour and Income Dynamics* (SLID) interview is conducted using computer-assisted interviewing (CAI). CAI is paperless interviewing. This document is therefore a written approximation of the CAI interview, or the questionnaire.

A preliminary interview of background information is collected for all respondents aged 16 and over who enter the *Survey of Labour and Income Dynamics* (SLID) sample. For the majority of the longitudinal respondents, this occurs when a new panel is introduced and the preliminary information is collected during the first labour and income interview. However, all persons living with a longitudinal respondent are also interviewed for SLID. Preliminary interviews are conducted for new household members (joiners) during their first labour and income interview after they join the household. Longitudinal persons who have turned 16 while their household is in the SLID sample are then eligible for SLID interviews so they are asked the preliminary interview questions during their first labour and income interview.

A labour and income interview is collected each year for all respondents 16 years of age and over. Respondents have the option of answering income questions during the interview, or of giving Statistics Canada permission to access their income tax records.

In January 2008, data was collected for reference year 2007 from panels 4 and 5. Panel 4, in its sixth and final year, consisted of approximately 18,600 households. Panel 5, in its third year, consisted of approximately 14,600 households.

This research paper p. sents the content of the 2008 preliminary, labour and income interview (for returnee year 2007), including question wording, possible responses and fix ws of questions.

2 Content

The preliminary interview is comprised of three main modules:

EX: Work experience – data on both part- and full-time work;

DE: Family and personal history – marital history, birth history, mother tongue, place of birth, ethnic origin;

EP: Educational attainment – certificates and degrees, years of schooling and parents' level of education. Although the EP questions are part of the preliminary interview, they are asked within the education (ED) module of the labour interview.

The labour and income interview is comprised of eight main modules:

DA: Dates – Employer start and end dates are collected for up to six employers during the year. This module has an employer roster (a list of all

employers the person worked for during the year) and employer names from the previous January are fed back. For a person on unpaid absence at the beginning of last January, the absence as well as the employer name is fed back.

Regarding "don't know" responses in employer dates: To collect information on an employer, the interviewer must be able to establish the date the person started working for that employer. If the interviewer is able to establish the month the job began, but not the day, the computer will set the day to 01 and the employer will be accepted. Similarly, if the interviewer can establish the month the job ended, but not the day, the computer will set the day to 28. However, if the interviewer cannot get an estimate of the month in which the job started or ended, it is impossible to proceed with that employer, and it is deleted from the roster. If the respondent reports no employers during the past year, the respondent skips to SE.

The following classification of jobs is used in D.A. **Job type 1** - a job at which the respondent was working on December 31st

on temporary lay-off or away on an absence of more than a week).

Job type 2 - a job at which the respondent was not working on December 31st of the previous reference year but to which he/she was attached (i.e.

Job type 3 - a job not ore viously identified in the survey, generally one at which the respondent started working during the reference year.

Jobless spells are derived from the dates of employment.

Employment with each employer is characterized as ended or un-ended, referring to whether the respondent was working for the employer at the end of the reference year. If a job type 1 is denied, the job is deleted without an array of probing questions. For job type 2, one probing question is asked if the job is denied.

CH: Characteristics – This will be collected for up to six employers per respondent. For job type 1 and 2, information on employer name, and type of work performed is fed back to the respondent. A change in occupation and wages can be recorded, as can one change in work schedule for job types 1 and 2. This allows greater precision in deriving implicit hourly wage rates or total annual earnings from an employer (total annual earnings from all employers will also be collected in the income interview). The number of absences of one week or more (except paid vacation), and details on the first and last absences with each employer are also recorded.

- SE: Search If there was a jobless spell identified in 'DA' or if the respondent did not work at any time in the year, the flow will be directed to this module. For each jobless spell, there are a series of questions on job search, and the desire for employment. For people who begin the year with a jobless spell, the search status in January is fed back to the respondent only if they were looking for work.
- CO: Compensation This module asks questions regarding receipt of Employment Insurance, Social Assistance, or Workers' Compensation and the months in which it was received during the reference year. This information is collected for everyone, independently of any reported job absences and jobless spells.
- SP: Spend This module requests information on support payments (both paid and received), child care expenses, and inter-household transfer payments (both monetary and non-monetary).
- ED: Education This module on formal education includes educational activity during the year, and degrees, certificates or diplomas obtained. If respondents attended more than one type of educational institution, several flows will result providing information also on field of study, program length, and time attended (months, weeks, hours). By asking question ED_Q150 about other degrees certificates or diplomas received during the reference year, this identifies situations where a respondent received a degree in the reference year although the program finished the previous year. Questions are as year to identify whether respondents have ever received a student loan and, if so, how much was borrowed and how much is still owed. The education module also contains a few questions on the most important work-related course taken by the respondent.
- DI: Disability This module contains questions concerning disability which are as led of all respondents. The basic structure of the questions concern disability at home, at work and in other activities, but a distinction is made in the questions asked for those who worked versus those who didn't work in the reference year. No questions are asked about disability at work for respondents aged 70+.
- IN: Income This module asks for the amounts of income received from various sources. Everyone age 16 and over receive these questions unless they give Statistics Canada permission to access their Canada Revenue Agency tax records. Edits are programmed using the information collected in the labour portion of the survey to remind respondents that they had reported being employed or receiving employment insurance, social assistance or workers' compensation, to ensure that the amounts are entered. Flags are also set during the labour interview so that amounts are

collected where applicable for: employer pension plan contributions; professional membership dues or malpractice insurance premium payments; and union dues.

The major components of the preliminary, labour and income modules are listed below.



The general flow of the p elim nary, labour and income interview is given in the flowchart on the next page.

An initial divergence based on age can be seen. Those aged 16-69 are asked the labour series of questions, while those 70 years and over flow to DA_Q001 (main activity), to the SP series of questions on inter-household transfer payments and then to the Pisability (DI) module. However, seniors who are eligible for the preliminary questions go to the EP questions before the DI questions. For those under age 70 who worked since the last interview, the characteristics of up to six jobs at a sked and any jobless spells are identified. If a jobless spell occurred, the respondent is asked the Search (SE) series of questions. These are also asked for respondents who have not worked since the last labour interview. The Compensation (CO) questions are then asked of all respondents, as are subsequent modules on Spend (SP), Education (ED) and Disability (DI). Income (IN) questions are only asked if the respondent does not give Statistics Canada permission to access their Canada Revenue Agency tax files.

3 How to read this document

This document is a written approximation of the CAI interview, or the "questionnaire". The CAI process is as follows:

- (a) A question appearing on the computer screen is read aloud to the respondent.
- (b) The respondent's answer is directly entered into the computer by the interviewer.
- (c) Based on the answer given, and/or age or other flow criteria, the computer determines the next question to be asked and displays it on the screen.

Question numbers: For each section, the question numbers refer to the actual numbers used in the collection application which appear on an interviewer's computer screen. Bold text is read, as worded, by the interviewer Instructions for the interviewer are preceded by the word, "INTERVIEWER" and are not read out loud to the respondent.

Naming conventions: Naming conventions were changed to conform to the standards for Statistics Canada social surveys.

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Questions with Q (e.g., EP_Q001) = question text read to a respondent C (e.g., EP_C001) = internal check
N (e.g., EP_N035) = interviewer instructions
E (e.g., EP_E001) = interviewer instruction edit

Pre-fill items: Shown in square brackets [], are items specific to each respondent's interview. The application inserts the relevant information into the question, making it simply a matter of reading for the interviewer. Pre-fill items include:

[respondent] – This is the first and last name of the household member to whom the questions refer. This is not necessarily the person who is talking to the interviewer.

[man. e] This is the first name of the household member to whom the questions refer. This is not necessarily the person who is talking to the interviewer

[current year] – This is the year **during which** the information is collected (2008).

[reference year] – This is the year **for which** the information is collected (2007).

[previous reference year] – This is the year prior to the reference year (2006).

[age] – This is the respondent's age in years, calculated as of January 1 of the current year.

[years ago] – This is the number of years ago the respondent first started working.

[employer] - This is the employer referred to in the question. Questions may be asked for a maximum of six employers. In each case, the specific employer's name is placed in the pre-fill item.

[class of worker] - Indicates whether the respondent is a paid worker, selfemployed or working in a family business without pay.

[type of work] - This is a short description of the respondent's occupation or type of work performed, at last contact.

[industry] - This is a description of the industry of the employer as provided by the respondent.

[start date] and [end date] - Depending on the question, these refer to either the start and end dates of a specific job, of an unpaid absence, or a jobless spell.

[prefill from Empl.oldwage and Empl.oldwageu] - Wage reported previous year for respondent.

Headers: For some questions, important information is not d at the top of the screen. In this document, this information is given at the beginning of each section description.

Ranges: Hard ranges are specified for some of the questions. The hard range gives the highest and lowest acceptable response values. The system will not accept a number outside the range. For example, in CH_Q110 (number of employees supervised directly) a hard range of 1 - 995 exits. If the interviewer tries to enter a number greater than 995, the system will not accept this.

The soft range specifies an upper limit which, if exceeded, will result in a probe to confirm that the amount entered is correct. If it is correct, the interviewer can enter it as long as it does not exceed the hard range. For example, if the respondent states that the number of people supervised was 65, this exceeds the soft range of > 60. If confirmed as correct, the interviewer can enter this amount as it does not exceed the 995 upper limit of the hard range.

Dates: Al' dates are in DD/MM/YYYY format unless otherwise specified.

4 What's new

New questions

ED_Q195, ED_S195

A new question and a specify question were added to ask if the respondent received any money for a scholarship, bursary or fellowship in the reference year. This information used to be reported in IN_Q125/IN_N125 in the income portion of the interview but is no longer available from the tax file and has therefore been dropped from the interview. Note: Research grants are still reported in IN_Q125/IN_N125.

IN 0037

For tax year 2006 there were changes in the legislation for dividends. Dividends are now reported on two lines instead of one on the tax form so an additional question has been added to SLID to collect the "taxable amount other than eligible dividends". The full taxable amount of dividends is still collected in IN_Q035.

IN Q067

Disability Benefits, included in Canada or Quebec Pension Plan benefits (CPP/QPP), are reported separately on the tax form. SLID has added this new question to identify the disability portion of the benefits received.

Modified questions

SP

Changes to the application logic have been made so that seniors with agy >69 will be asked the Spend questions on inter-household transfer payments (SF_Q050 to SP_Q095). Previously, seniors skipped from question DA_0001 (main activity) to the DI questions.

ED_Q155, 190

There was a flow change for response 01 'high 'cl. ool' lue to the deletion of question ED_Q156. There was also a flow change for DK/R responses.

EP

Changes to the application logic have seen made so that seniors with age >69 will be asked the EP questions if they are eligible for the preliminary interview questions. Previously, seniors skipped from question DA_Q001 (main activity) to the DI questions.

ED_C195

Logic was added for this collection only to read a new flag on the input file (Compinfo.Edprfg59 = 1) which was set for seniors who missed the EP questions for two previous collections.

EP_Q072

The question was renumbered to EP_Q081 because it was moved and is now asked after EP_Q080.

EP_Q081

The original EP_Q081 was renumbered to EP_Q082.

IN N125

"Scholarships, bursaries and fellowships" have been removed from this question. The information will be collected in the Educ module (in new questions ED_Q195 and ED_S195).

An age check has been added so that if the respondent is under age 60 they will skip this question (Old age security pension, guaranteed income supplement, spouse's allowance from federal government).

6.6 ED Module

The EDUC module basically covers two types of training activities. The first series of questions (ED_Q021 to ED_Q190) deals with "training programs". A program is a series of courses offered by, through or under the auspices of an educational institution (private or public) that are used as credits towards a degree, diploma or certificate.

The education module captures all institutions attended by the respondent auring the reference year and all degrees, certificates or diplomas completed. This results in a series of flows for each type of institution attended (ED_Q020). For example: if a respondent attended high school and university, we would ask ED_Q021 to ED_Q026 and ED_Q130 to ED_Q175. If another attended community college and then a business or commercial school we would ask ED_Q030 to ED_Q070.

If ED_Q005 = "Yes" (attended an educational institution in the reference year), and flows for attending all institutions have been completed, ED_Q150 asks about any other degrees, certificates or diplomas received during the reference year. This identifies situations where a respondent received a degree in the reference year although the program finished the previous year.

Without ED_Q150, these "degrees" would not be recorded. Similarly, if ED_Q005 = "No" then ED_Q181 will also pick up these hidden "degrees", that is degrees or certificates awarded after the year that the respondent attended the institution.

The second series of questions (ED_Q300 to ED_Q350) deals with job-related "training courses". For the purpose of the questionnaire, training activities such as courses, seminars, workshops, conferences and forums are covered by these questions.
