## Questionnaire Package

This package briefly describes the content, methodology and sample of the Violence Against Women Survey. Copies of all components of the questionnaire, as well as a brief questionnaire annotation, are attached, including: the Control Form, Violence Against Women Survey questionnaire, Victimization Report, Intimate Abuse Report, and Mini Report.

The Violence Against Women Survey was conducted between February, 1993 and the end of May, 1993. The following issues were addressed: perceptions of personal safety and measures taken to reduce risk of violent victimization; sexual harassment; experiences of physical and sexual assault by strangers, dates/boyfriends, husbands and common-law partners, and other known men; power/control and emotional abuse by husbands/partners; spouse abuse in family of origin; the impact of the experience on women who report violence; who they turn to for help; and, involvement and satisfaction with the criminal justice system. Two questionnaires were used to conduct the survey:

A Control Form was completed for each telephone number selected in the sample. It collects basic demographic information for all household members, including age, sex, marital status and relationship to a reference person. A woman 18 years of age or older was randomly selected from all eligible respondents in the household and a Violence Against Women questionnaire was completed for this person. Details about non-spousal violence were gathered through a Victimization Report, and details about violence by husbands and common-law partners were gathered through an Intimate Abuse Report. In the case of a respondent reporting more than one violent victimization, one incident was selected at random. A Mini Report was available to respond to requests by respondents to provide details about an alternate or second incident.

## Sample

The target population for this survey was English and French speaking women, 18 years of age and over, residing in households in the ten provinces. The Random Digit Dialling approach was used to select households, and eligible respondents were randomly selected within the households contacted.

The total sample for the Violence Against Women Survey is expected to be 15,000 interviews.
