

File Naming Conventions

Representing the data coverage, files are either named by a region, Statistics Canada census subdivision (CSD) number, or a Standard Industrial Classification.

File Names by Region



File Names by 1996 Census Subdivision (CSD)

Census Subdivision is the general term applied to municipalities (as determined by provincial legislation) or their equivalent, for example Indian reserves, Indian settlements and unorganized territories.

All files are prefixed with the Census Subdivision Code. An additional text file (CSD.txt) containing a CSD and its associated municipality name is included in each order by CSD.

File Names of EPOI Look Up Tables

Look up tables contain information such as; the number of beds in a hospital, the location code of an airport, and the grade range taught within a school. Look up tables are linked to the main table via the POI_ID field. For example, a record in the POI database that has an EPOI_TYPE = POL (Police Services) links via the POI_ID field to the "pol" (Police Services) look up table.

It is common for businesses or other recreational facilities to share addresses, for example in skyscrapers or shopping centers. The EPOI product has a feature that allows users to identify records that have common addresses. A group by query on the CAF field will allow a user to extract a single record by address. The CAF is an alphanumeric code that is unique to a unique address.

- 3. In Project Window, click 'Views'. Press "New" to add a view.
- 4. Select View > Add Event Theme. Select the correct table, and X/Y coordinate fields from the EPOI.txt file. Click OK.
- 5. In the View select the EPOI.txt layer to make the layer active.
- Select Theme > Convert to Shapefile > Navigate to the location where the files will be saved. Name the file and Click OK. When ArcView asks to add the shapefile as a theme to the view, Press YES. The new theme with the .shp extension will appear in the view.

Creating Projection Datum Metadata (*.prj files):

- 7. In the same project, from the Menu > File > Extensions. Scroll down to Projection Utility Wizard, click on the checkbox and Click OK.
- 8. File > ArcView Projection Utility. In Step 1, select the shape file and press Next. In Step 2, the 'Coordinate System Type' should be "Geographic". From the 'Name' dropdown box, select "GCS_North_American_1983 [4269]", and the units in "Degree [9102]", then press Next. ArcView will ask to save the coordinate system information, press Yes and a Project file (*.prj) will be created with the shape files. Cancel out of the Utility. To continue would actually re-project the files.

Opening Lookup tables in ArcView:

- 9. In the same project, click from the Project Window Tables. Press Add to bring in the lookup table. Click Open to see the database.
- 10. File Export this will convert the text file to a dBASE format for ArcView. Select the location to save and press OK.
- 11. The text version of the lookup table can be deleted from the project. Open the new dBASE file.
- 12. Repeat for each lookup table as required.

Linking Lookup tables to the main EPOI table

To view the main EPOI table linked to the Look up tables, the files should be manually joined. To join the files use the following directions:

- 13. View both the main EPOI table and the Look up table (attribute tables)
- 14. Click on the POI_ID fields from both the main EPOI table and the Look up table
- 15. Click on the Join button (or choose Join from the Table menu).
- 16. Additional Look up tables can be joined, so that many tables' attributes can be shown at one time. To undo the joins between the tables, click on the attribute table, making it active, and from the 'Table' menu select 'Remove All Joins'.

ArcGIS 8.1

Opening txt file(s) and Creating ArcMap files:

- 1. Start with a new empty map. Click OK.
- 2. File > Add Data > navigate to the EPOI.txt files and Click Add.

Note: "ON" is an SQL statement in ArcGIS and therefore ON.txt cannot be opened and must be renamed as ONT.txt. The renaming of this file will not affect the link to the Ontario lookup table.

Creating Graphics from Coordinate Fields:

- 3. Tools > Add X, Y Data > choose the table and the X, Y fields.
- Choose the coordinate system by clicking Edit. Then from 'Select Coordinate System', select Geographical Coordinate System, then North America, then North American Datum 1983. Click Add, then Apply, then OK. A project file (*.prj) is created containing the coordinate information.
- 5. Make the event theme active (ie. EPOI.txt Events).
- Right click on the 'Events' theme, choose 'Data', then 'Export Data'. Export all features. Click on the 'Use the same Coordinate System as the data frame' button. Browse to specify where the theme will be stored. Click OK.
- 7. ArcMap will ask to add the layer to the view. Click Yes. Remove the 'Events' theme.




Figure 4: Creating graphics from coordinate fields

Appendix B: Provincial and Territorial Abbreviations and Codes⁹

The provincial/territorial names, abbreviations and numeric codes reflect those in effect on January 1, 2001 with the exception of the name change of the province of Newfoundland and Labrador (previously Newfoundland), which came into effect on December 6, 2001. Newfoundland and Labrador was recognized by the alpha code NL (formerly NF). There were no changes to the numeric code (10) and abbreviations for Newfoundland and Labrador.

On April 1, 1999 the Northwest Territories was divided into two territories to create Nunavut Territory. The province/territory numeric code for Nunavut is 62 whereas the code for the Northwest Territories remained at 61. On December 18, 2000, Canada Post has introduced a new alpha code (NU) for Nunavut.

Appendix D: Standard Industrial Classification Codes

What is an SIC Code?

Standard Industrial Classification (SIC) codes are four digit numerical codes that were established in 1987 by the U.S. Government. The codes were assigned to businesses to group and identify their primary area of business activity and to facilitate the collection of economic data for statistical analysis by federal, state, and private organizations. The SIC code classifications cover all economic related activities including agriculture, forestry & fishing; mining; construction; manufacturing; transportation, communications, electric, gas, and sanitary services; wholesale trade; retail trade; finance, insurance, real estate; health, education, recreation and other services; and public administration.

SIC Division is represented by a single letter, for example Division G refers to Retail Trade. Each Division represents a broad area of economic activity:

The following information is sourced directly from the CCRA website and provides definitions and explanations of the data contained in the Border Crossings and Customs (bor) look up table:

Explanation of Columns

2. The detailed office information is presented in an eight-column table that follows a standardized pattern with some exceptions.

Port No. (Column 1)

3. The number in the first column of the table indicates the office number or port number as specified in the Accelerated Commercial Release Operations Support System (ACROSS). Offices that have a number in the first column and nothing in the second column are **independent offices**, and they do not report through any other office or location.

4. Locations that have a number in both the first and second column are **subordinate offices** that generally process their transactions through another office. An Inland Alternate Service (IAS) site reports to an independent office called a hub. Subordinate offices have their number in the first column and the number and name of the office they report to in the second column.

Note: Transactions may be processed using either number, depending on local preferences.

5. **Service sites** such as sufferance warehouses and marinas usually do not have a distinct number. They process all their transactions using an independent office number.

Reports to Office (Column 2)

6. This column presents the number and name of the independent office through which subordinate offices or service sites process their transactions.

Customs Office (Column 3)

7. The third column contains the name, and where applicable, the address and telephone numbers of the office or site. Customs offices and service sites include actual staffed customs offices, airports, vessel clearance terminals, offices that are serviced by staff from another location, sufferance warehouses, and CANPASS locations. Not all locations or facilities provide all services, and some facilities may be restricted to certain types of traffic or classes of goods. Offices names followed by "IAS" indicate that they have been designated as an area that is serviced through the Inland Alternate Service program.

Hierarchy of Offices and Sites

8. In general, each region is divided into an individual appendix and then sub-divided into districts within that appendix. (Note: Southern Ontario has recently been reorganized as one region with three separate divisions. For formatting purposes only, this document treats each division as if it were a separate region, resulting in a separate appendix for Southern Ontario (Inland), Southern Ontario (Niagara/Fort Erie), and Southern Ontario (Windsor/St. Clair)). Wherever possible, the primary or independent offices are listed in numerical order with their subordinate offices and service sites listed immediately after them. As a result of this, some subordinate offices may initially appear to be out of numerical order. However, they are actually in their appropriate place under the primary or the hub through which they process their transactions.

9. Finally, a third level of sorting has been applied to the information provided in column 3. Having been first grouped by the independent office number and then the subordinate office numbers in columns 1 and 2, the various offices and sites are prioritized according to the type of function or service they provide.

10. The general categories are, in descending order:

(a) independent office and subordinate offices;

(b) airports;

(c) marine facilities;

(d) rail stations and depots;

(e) warehouses; and

(f) CANPASS service sites.

Hours of Service (Columns 4 and 5)

11. The hours of service indicate the hours that have been officially designated as the times when the customs office is normally open for business. Locations that are listed as being open 24 hours per day, 7 days a week may not provide all services during the entire 24-hour period. For example, some offices may provide full release and accounting services during the day shift, Monday to Friday, but may not have full accounting services available during the evenings or weekends. Clients are encouraged to verify hours of operation with their local offices. Requests for new or expanded services, or services outside the normal business hours, may be subject to cost recovery or special service charges.

12. Further information about the authorized hours of service at customs offices may be obtained by referring to Memorandum D1-2-1, *Special Services*.

Services (Column 6)

13. The symbols shown in column 6 indicate the specific services or activities available at the customs office or service site. The definitions are not necessarily all-inclusive and should be used as a guide only.

HWY - Land and Inland Border Office - authorized port of entry at which passenger, general public, or commercial highway traffic is permitted to report. Land borders include both CANADA/U.S. border crossing points and inland border points.

EDI - Electronic Data Interchange - the transmission, transfer, interchange, or electronic release of accounting data.

IAS - Inland Alternate Service - the provision of release services to inland locations from a hub. **COMMERCIAL - Designated Commercial Office** - offices that provide commercial service free from the imposition of any special service charges on a 7 day/24 hour basis.

IMM - Immigration - an immigration officer is on site.

NTO - Non-Terminal Office - office is not equipped with a computer communication system. **POST - International Mail Centre** - office at which the processing of international mail or the control of outstanding postal accounts occurs.

AERO-INTL - International Airport - authorized customs airport of entry and exit for clearance of all classes of air traffic (Airport of Entry Designator Code AOE-A - see Memorandum D2-5-1, *Charter Access to Airports*).

AERO-REG - Regional Airport - authorized customs airport of entry and exit for clearance of commercial air traffic carrying freight or a passenger load not exceeding the capacity limits specified (Airport of Entry Designator Code AOE-R or AOE-RA - see Memorandum D2-5-1).

AERO-GEN - General Aviation Airport - authorized customs airport of entry and exit for general aviation air traffic, i.e., privately operated or small charter aircraft carrying no more than 15 passengers and their baggage (Airport of Entry Designator Code AOE-X or AOE-XA - see Memorandum D2-5-1).

SeaPI - Sea Plane Landing Site - authorized point of entry for sea planes.

C-Ves - Commercial Vessel Clearing Station - locations at which commercial vessels are permitted to report.

P-Ves - Private or Non-Commercial Vessel Reporting Station - locations at which non-commercial vessels (pleasure crafts) are permitted to report.

FERRY - Ferry Terminal - terminal where passengers and vehicles embark or disembark from a ferry.

CSO - Cruise Ship Operations - authorized debarkation site for cruise ship passengers and crew. **RAIL - Railway Depot** - first point in Canada at which a passenger or freight train stops and discharges passengers or goods.

SWH - Warehouse - highway sufferance warehouses or special bonded warehouses for perishable goods.

Shop - Duty-Free Shop - a duty-free shop is located at the customs location. More specific duty-free shop details can be obtained from Memorandum D4-3-2, *Duty Free Shop - Licensing*.

ACEEO - locations at which acting Revenue Canada enforcement officers have been authorized.

- CPO Only the CANPASS programs are serviced at this location
- CPA CANPASS Private and Corporate Aircraft
- CPB CANPASS Private Boat
- CPL CANPASS Voyageur

Note: All references to CANPASS programs, services, or sites refer to a CANPASS pilot project that was being tested at the time this document was released.

Airport or Vessel Code (Column 7)

14. This column identifies the airport designator code, the passenger capacity limits per flight for inspection services purposes, and the station responsible for flight plans. Further information regarding services provided at airports can be obtained from Memorandum D3-2-1, *International Air Traffic*, and Memorandum D2-5-1. Vessel registration office numbers are also included in this section.

Opposite U.S. Office (Column 8)

15. The U.S. customs office is opposite the Canadian customs office.

Appendix F: Canadian Payments Association Classification

The Canadian Payments Association (CPA) developed a classification system, which divides the institutions belonging to the payments associations into three groups:

- 1. Banks
- 2. Credit Unions and Caisses Populaires
