



- Insert the WTA Installation CD Version 1.40
- There is an AUTORUN which will execute “SETUP.EXE”




- There are two parts to the installation
- 1) ORACLE INSTALLER
- 2) INSTALL TRADE ANALYZER SUITE

- START THE ORACLE INSTALLER

You will receive a warning to change the path of the “Oracle Home” location to “C:\analyzer”




During the installation, it is **very important** to **change the path** for the Default Home to **C:\analyzer** .



You will then be prompted to know what to install in C:\Analyzer

- Using the **CTRL** button, **choose** all the ones that need to be installed (here below) and **then click on the INSTALL** button.


Choose: Oracle Express Analyzer 2.1.0, Oracle Express Connection Editor 2.1.0, Oracle Express Relational Access Manager Support Files 2.1.0, Oracle Express Spreadsheet Add-In (32bit) 2.2.0.1, Oracle Installer 3.3.1.1.0, Oracle SNAPI 6.1.0.1.0, Personal Express Single User 5.0.3.0.0



- During the installation, whenever you are asked to do either a Typical or Custom setup, just **choose Typical**.
- During the Oracle Express Analyzer installation, **choose** the first option “**Install Oracle Express Analyzer for Single User**”, afterwards, **you don’t need to select any demo databases**.
- When you come back to the “**Software Asset Screen**”, just press on the **Exit** button.


Before continuing with the WTA installation, we **need to install the Oracle patch**.

- Browse the WTA Installer CD-ROM and go in **.\PATCH** and execute the **“Xoea215.exe”** file and the click on **“Unzip”** .




- **Afterwards, go back to the main SETUP screen**, or if you closed it by accident, re-execute the **.\SETUP.EXE** on the CD-ROM.

- Choose option 2 now, “INSTALL TRADE ANALYZER SUITE”
- Click on the “WTA” button.



- You will receive a warning to make sure to change the patch to “C:\Analyzer\olap\oea205”




- Just keep pressing Next, do not change anything...




- The installation is now complete... **Reboot** the computer first before continuing.

TIME TO PERFORM THE ONE-TIME CONFIGURATION OF WTA

- Insert the WTA 1985-200x CD that you want to use in your CD-ROM drive
- Go into Start>Programs (or All Program)>Trade Analyzer Suite>World Trade Analyzer
- When the ORACLE EXPRESS ANALYSER shows up, **check “Save Settings”**, **uncheck “Show this dialog box at Startup”** so that this box doesn’t show up every time and the **click on “OK”**




- Click on **System Settings**
- Change the path to the CD-ROM using “\\” each time you need a backslash, you need to **end with “\”** (i.e.: for WTA 1985-2000 use D:\\00\\)
- Click on the “**Attached**” check box
- For 1024x768, change the Screen Diagonal to **16”** and then press the “**Reset**” button and then “**Return**” and then “**Exit**”



TIME TO PERFORM THE “UPDATE” OF THE VERSION YOU WISH TO USE

Note: You may switch between the different CD-ROM’s (2000, 2001 and 2003) back and forth, but every time you do, you must run the update on your CD-ROM to see all of its contents when you enter the program

Insert the CD-ROM you wish to use (not the installation CD-ROM) and find the **UPDATE.EXE** file, **execute it** and then press **“Unzip”**.



You can now access the WTA by launching the application and choosing **“Table View”**

Changing the screen diagonal afterwards:

- Go in the program
- Click on the “Top Screen” menu
- Click on “System Settings”
- Change the “Screen Diagonal” and press “Reset” and then “Return”
- Go back in “Table View”, then back to “Top Screen” then “Exit”

Uninstalling WTA

- Go to *Start>Programs>Trade Analyzer Suite* and then **right click** on *World Trade Analyzer* and then click on **properties**
- Memorize the current installation path (Target Location) (ie: c:\orant or C:\analyzer)
- Close down the **properties** Window
- Go in the **Control Panel**, go to **Add/Remove Programs** and then Uninstall “*World Trade Analyzer*”
- Close the *Add/Remove Programs* Windows as well as the *Control Panel*
- Go to Start>Run and then type “regedit” and press Enter
- Go to HKEY_Local Machine>SOFTWARE and then **delete** the “Oracle” key (You must do this if you wish to re-install Oracle in a different location).
- Close the “Registry Editor” (regedit)
- Go, using either “My Computer” or “Windows Explorer” to the installation path that you memorized initially and delete the entire directory.
